

Price Guide



Commissions

One of the first questions many people ask is how much will their idea cost. The answer is that I don't know until I draw it and figure out how to make it.

The price of a commission is dictated by its complexity, the costs of the materials and the cost of the processes involved.

As a basic guide:

- Pieces in Silver: from £180
- Pieces in 9ct Gold: £280
- Pieces in 18ct Gold: £580
- Diamond Engagement Rings: from £750
- Plain wedding bands from £100 in Silver, £220 in 9ct, £450 in 18ct and £450 in Platinum.

Remodelling

Remodelling existing jewellery is an increasingly popular choice. It preserves the sentiment of materials while changing their form to better suit you.

While it can save money on materials it's often a labour intensive process. The cost of remodelling reflects this and the price is dictated by the design's complexity and the cost of the processes involved.

As a basic guide:

- Making plain wedding bands from £250
- Making flush/pavé set plain bands from £350
- Making simple stone set items from £400
- Making complex stone set items (including rings) from £650


Extra metal/gemstones can be sourced to add to your materials.

Terms & Conditions

Bespoke Jewellery

- 1. Upon receipt of any enquiry from a Client, Becca Williams will communicate with them to establish the piece of Jewellery required and the style and design, sizing, and their budget.
- 2. Becca Williams will then prepare designs and specifications.
- 3. Becca Williams will answer all reasonable questions from the Client and seek to find a design acceptable to the Client.
- 4. Becca Williams will use their best endeavours to answer all questions and requirements from the Client, but this is subject to reasonable use of time.
- 5. Once the Client has agreed a design the Client will be given a full quote in writing and invoiced for 50% of the Fee and any Delivery Charge.
- 6. The quotation will be based upon the prices of the materials including stones at that time and due to the varying market only guaranteed for seven days.
- 7. Becca Williams may ask for the full Fee upfront in some circumstances.
- 8. Any changes to the original style or design may incur an increase in the Fee although the Client must accept that in some cases changes may not be possible.
- 9. Once the invoice has been paid Becca Williams will create the Jewellery.
- 10. Once the initial Fee has been paid, necessary materials will be ordered and the work commenced, no refunds will be issued as the Jewellery is individual and personalised for the Client.
- 11. When the Jewellery is finished the Client will be sent a photograph and an invoice for the balance of the Fee and any Delivery Charge.
- 12. Once paid Becca Williams will send the finished Jewellery by Royal Mail to the Client or courier as they decide to be appropriate. The Client can collect from the Studio if they wish.

Provision of Stones or other materials by the Client

- 1. If the Client provides a stone or other material e.g., gold they must sign a waiver before any work can commence excluding Becca Williams from any liability should damage occur to the material or the Jewellery.
- 2. Becca Williams may require the stones or materials to be independently verified as to their authenticity and content.
- 3. Becca Williams has the right to refuse to use any stone or material supplied by the Client if she is not satisfied that the result will be of the appropriate standard.
- 4. Becca Williams may refuse to work with imported jewels, any replicas, white gold, rhodium plated metals, opals, pearls, or emeralds.



Terms & Conditions continued

Design Issues

- 1. The Client cannot reject any item of Jewellery following provision of a bespoke item, personalised jewellery or any repairs to Jewellery based on issues with style and design.
- 2. Becca Williams will endeavour to communicate any proposals with the Client and enter a dialogue to find a design to their satisfaction. The Client must inform Becca Williams immediately if they are not happy with what has been shown or described to them so that changes can be made.
- 3. The Client accepts that changes in design, gemstones or materials could lead to an increase in the Fee.
- 4. Becca Williams may terminate any Contract for the provision of Bespoke Jewellery if she believes she will be unable to reach an agreement with the Client within a reasonable timeframe as to the design of the Jewellery.

1.General Guarantee.

- 1. Becca Williams will offer a one-year guarantee for workmanship on Standard Collection Jewellery and Bespoke Jewellery excluding any issues arising from the use of materials provided by the Client or failure to care properly for the Jewellery.
- 2. The guarantee will not apply if the Jewellery is damaged or not stored correctly rendering it unsaleable.
- 3. Becca Williams offers no guarantee if the Client provides their own gemstones and/or metal as she cannot be totally sure of the quality and suitability of the products.
- 4. Becca Williams offers no guarantee for any Jewellery she considers having been treated badly and where proper care has not been taken.
- 5. All Clients are expected to follow the care instructions given to the Client.

2.The Fee

- 1. For Bespoke Jewellery, a proportion of the Fee and any Delivery Charge is liable when the order is placed and the balance when completed before any Jewellery is delivered.
- 2. For Repairs any Fee must be paid in full before the Jewellery is returned to the Client.
- 3. The Fee must be paid as required on the Website where Standard Collection Jewellery is ordered.
- 4. All invoices must be paid in full without set-off, deduction or counterclaim.
- 5. Any invoice not paid within 30 days of issue will incur interest at 8% above base rate until paid in full. Standard debt recovery charges will also be added.

Cancellation Policy

- 1. Should a client wish to cancel the provision of a piece of Bespoke Jewellery they must contact Becca Williams and discuss the reasons for this. If the initial invoice has been paid and materials ordered the initial payment will be retained. If no work has been carried out or materials ordered the payment will be returned.
- 2. If the Client wishes to cancel the provision of repairs once the work has commenced, they must pay Becca Williams for all work and materials used to date of cancellation before the Jewellery is returned in its condition at that point.
- 3. Private individuals cannot cancel once the guarantee period of 14 days set out above has passed following purchase of Standard Collection Jewellery except in accordance with their legal rights.
- 4. Becca Williams reserves the right to cancel an order without liability if she is unable to supply the Jewellery ordered due to events beyond their control.
